Your new recreational facilities at Rockdale and Brighton-Le-Sands

The M6 Stage 1 will connect President Avenue at Kogarah to the New M5 at Arncliffe, connecting southern Sydney to the wider motorways network.

Our construction activities will have a temporary impact on open space and the recreational facilities at Rockdale Bicentennial Park.

We understand how important this area is for you and are continuing to progress our plans to upgrade existing facilities at Ador Park and McCarthy Reserve, Rockdale and Brighton Memorial Playing Fields, before construction starts.

Thank you to everyone who provided us with feedback on the Recreation facilities at Rockdale and Brighton-Le-Sands Review of Environmental Factors (REF) in December 2019.
