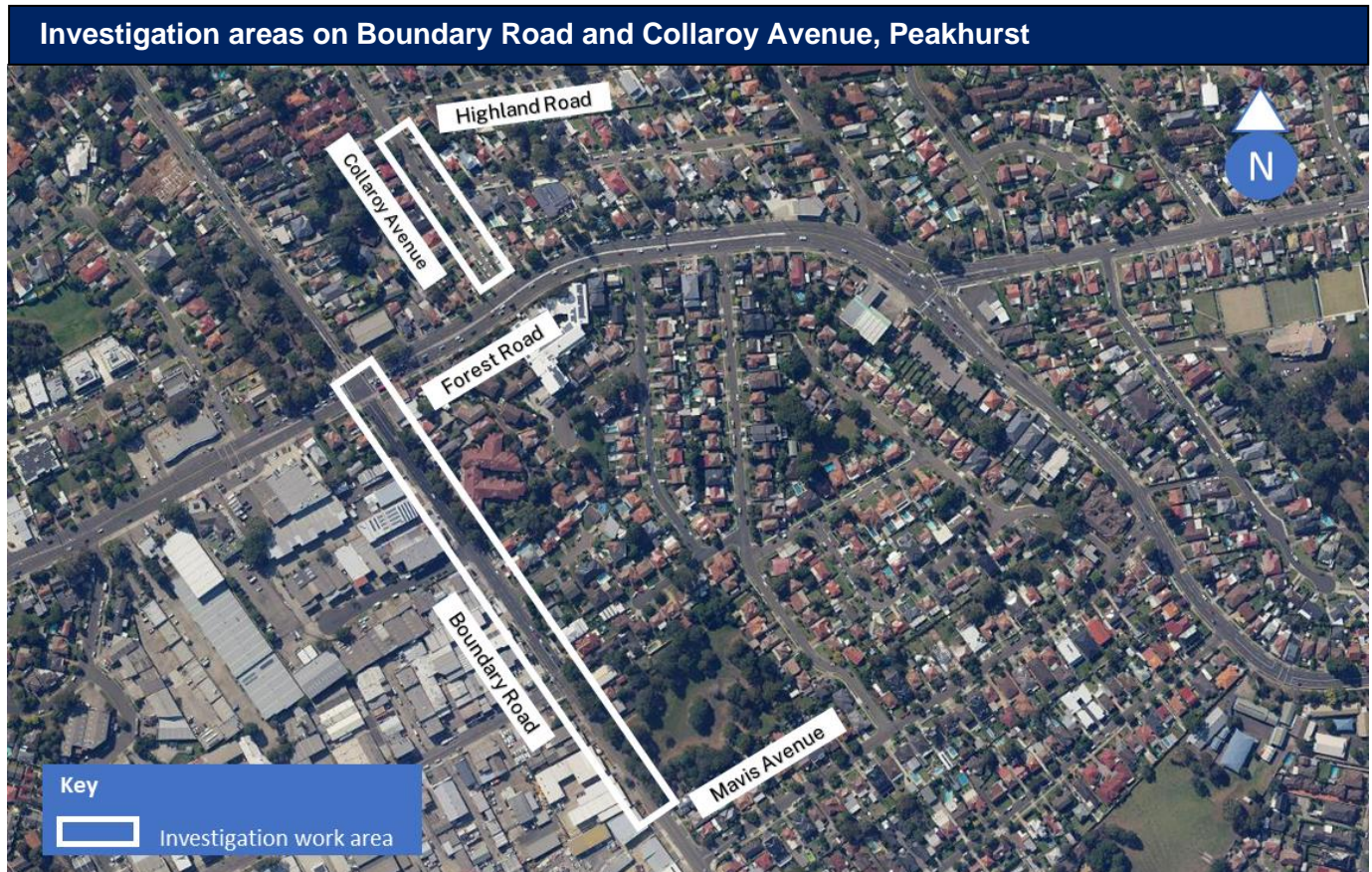
Investigation works on Boundary Road and Collaroy Avenue, Peakhurst from 4 July 2022

The NSW Government is funding intersection improvements at Forest, Bonds and Boundary Roads, Peakhurst as part of the Urban Road Congestion Program to improve safety for road users.

Transport for NSW will undertake utilities investigation work at two locations along Boundary Road and Collaroy Avenue to help us plan for the project.

The investigations will include topographical and utilities surveys at:

- Boundary Road from Forest Road to Mavis Avenue
- Collaroy Avenue from Highland Road to Forest Road



Our work schedules

We will be on site for **10** day shifts between **4 July** and **30 July**, weather permitting. We will not work on public holidays.

Our day work hours will be from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and from **8am to 1pm on Saturday**.
