

Noise barrier early work on the Princes Highway, Berry from October 2020

The NSW Government has committed to installing two noise barriers to address concerns raised by the community in Berry.

A contract has been awarded for the installation of noise barriers along two sections of the Princes Highway, near Windsor Drive and Huntingdale Park Road in Berry.

Our work schedule

We will be on site to carry out early work from **October 2020**.

This work will include geotechnical investigations, survey work and minor vegetation removal.

Construction of the part solid part transparent panelled noise barriers is expected to start in **early 2021**, weather permitting.

We will keep the community updated on the progress of the project.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise and dust impacts with this early work.

We will make every effort to minimise noise for residents and complete work as quickly as possible.

Traffic changes

There may be temporary traffic changes during the early work to ensure the work zone is safe.

Motorists are advised there may be minor delays during the project. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
