

Start of construction of noise barriers on the Princes Highway at Berry from 20 May

The NSW Government is installing two noise barriers near Windsor Drive and Huntingdale Park Road in Berry.

What are we doing?

We will be clearing vegetation, drilling holes and installing steel posts and noise barrier panels.

We will be working between **7am and 6pm, from Monday to Friday**.

Work is expected to start on **20 May** and be completed by **October**, weather permitting.

How will this work affect you?

There may be some noise and dust impacts associated with this work.

We will make every effort to minimise noise for residents and complete work as quickly as possible.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures in place.

During work hours the northbound section of Queen Street between Victoria Street and Kangaroo Valley Road will be closed. A detour will be in place via Victoria Street and George Street.

From **9am to 3pm, Monday to Friday** the Princes Highway will be reduced to one lane in each direction.

During these hours a reduced speed limit of 40km/hr will be in place. Outside of these hours the speed limit will be 80km/hr.

Road users are advised there may be minor delays during the project.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
