Foxground and Berry bypass, Princes Highway upgrade Huntingdale Park Road Berry (south) interchange

I am sending you this letter as part of our commitment to keep residents informed of the latest project developments.

As a result of both resident and broader community comment and feedback the Roads and Maritime Services (RMS), formally the RTA, has made revisions to the Berry (south) interchange. The main amendments are:

- The re-alignment of the northbound off-ramp to avoid Huntingdale Park Road.
- Relocation of the Huntingdale Park Road junction with Kangaroo Valley Road, west of its current position.

A map of the new interchange arrangement, which will have additional property impacts, is shown on the reverse.

Improvements for Huntingdale Park Road residents

This proposed design would improve safety and amenity for Huntingdale Park Road residents:

- Retains existing access arrangements for residents.
- Retains low traffic pedestrian environment.
- Retains existing on street parking.
- Adjusted ramp has reduced noise impact.

RMS has also recently released new information about changes to the proposed bypass alignment along the northern edge of Berry.
