Weekend work on Princes Highway between Toolijooa Road and Tindalls Lane, 13 & 14 December 2014

The NSW Government is funding \$580,000,000 for the Foxground and Berry bypass project. To progress construction, work is required to add a protective coating to the Eastern Gas Pipeline.

Work is required on the eastern side of the Princes Highway to add a protective coating to the gas pipeline in the area. Due to recent rain, work will need to be carried out on **Saturday 13 December from 8am to 5pm, and Sunday 14 December from 9am to 4pm.**

Work will include the use of an air compressor and may involve some noise. There will be no impact to traffic.
