Foxground and Berry bypass

The NSW Government is funding the \$580 million Foxground and Berry bypass to improve road safety and traffic efficiency.

Early investigation work has recently been carried out along the new road. This has included survey work and geotechnical and utility investigations to prepare for the start of major construction works in early 2015.

From September 2014, early works will start including building the project site office compound, putting up property boundary fencing, relocation of electricity, water and telecommunications services, demolition of structures and minor clearing of vegetation for these activities.

The project site office and community display centre will be located at 59 Woodhill Mountain Road, Berry. The site office will be on the western side of Woodhill Mountain Road immediately north of the Bundewallah Creek Bridge. The existing house on the property will be used as the project's community display centre which will open in early 2015.

The project office in Broughton Court, Berry will continue operating as well as the new display centre.

Construction hours:

Work will be carried out during normal working hours:

- Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm
- Saturdays 8am to 1pm

Nearby residents will be advised if it becomes necessary to carry out any work outside of these hours.

Should work need to be carried out on private properties, Fulton Hogan will liaise directly with residents and landowners to discuss the work and its impacts and to obtain permission to access private property before the work starts.
