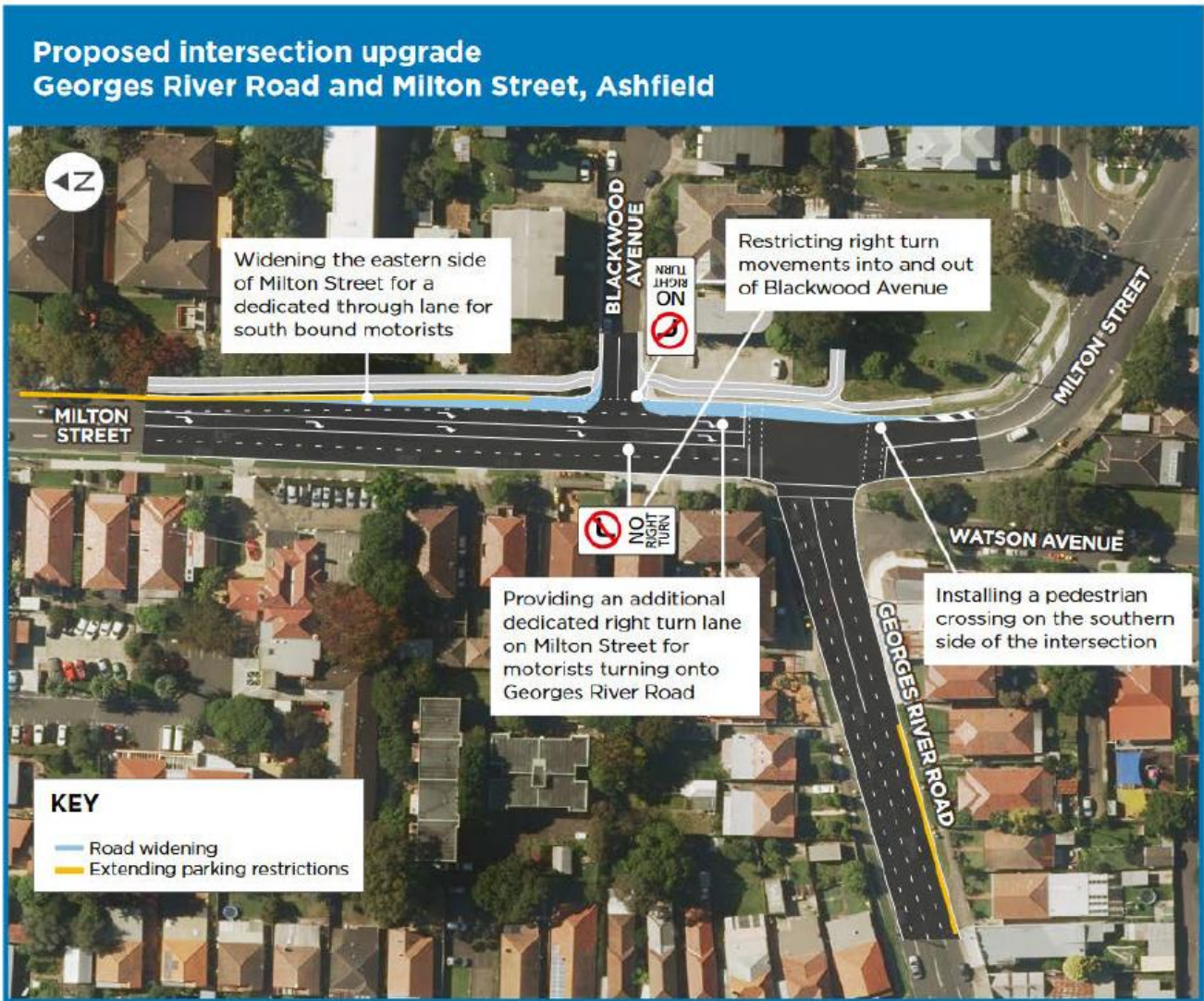
Upcoming work for intersection improvements at Georges River Road and Milton Street, Ashfield, from Tuesday 15 September 2020

The Australian and NSW Governments are upgrading the intersection at Georges River Road and Milton Street, Ashfield to reduce congestion and improve safety.

Intersection upgrade

A high number of vehicles currently use the intersection of Georges River Road and Milton Street in Ashfield. It is a congested intersection with thousands vehicles movements through the area in peak periods.

The project will decrease queuing at the intersection and ease congestion by allowing more vehicles to travel through the intersection. Construction is planned to begin in late 2020.



Our Proposed Schedule

Due to high traffic volumes in the area, the majority of construction work for this project will be carried out at night. Our proposed schedule involves working up to five nights a week between **December 2020** and **August 2022**, weather permitting and excluding public holidays.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm and 5am from Sunday to Thursday**. Our day work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Investigation work

We will conduct investigation work on **Georges River Road and Milton Street, Ashfield** between **Tuesday 15 September and Sunday 27 September 2020**, weather permitting. Our night work hours will be between **9pm and 5am**. We will work Monday to Thursday night each week.

How will the work affect you?

Our work will be noisy at times, but we will be completing the noisier activities by **midnight**. Some side streets will also be impacted. This work will include testing the existing ground conditions and identifying the location of utilities.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
