

Saving travel time on Georges River Road in Croydon Park

New turning lanes at Lees Avenue, Croydon Park

Roads and Maritime Services has recently completed improvements to the intersection of Georges River Road, Lees Avenue and Portland Street in Croydon Park.

Funded by the NSW Government, the project has improved the traffic flow at the intersection, providing a more reliable and safer journey for all road users.

The work involved removing the existing concrete median and parking spaces on Lees Avenue, so we could create dedicated left, through and right turn lanes for motorists travelling north. We also made changes on Portland Street, by banning the right turn from Portland Street onto Georges River Road and creating dedicated through and left lanes.

We also adjusted the traffic light phasing and added left turning arrows from Portland Street onto Georges River Road to increase pedestrian safety at the intersection.

Key benefits

- More green light time for the busiest parts of the intersection
- Reducing travel times and providing more reliable journeys for road users
- Reducing congestion and improving traffic flow at the intersection particularly in peak periods
- Improving safety for pedestrians and road users.
