

Gerringong upgrade

Temporary night time road closures of Fern Street and changes to night work at Belinda Street, Gerringong.

The NSW Government is funding the \$329 million Princes Highway upgrade at Gerringong to improve road safety and traffic efficiency.

To prepare for the upcoming traffic changes on the Princes Highway between Mount Pleasant and Fern Street, temporary night time road closures of Fern Street is expected for two nights.

There will be no access to or from the Princes Highway at Fern Street on Wednesday 26 November and Thursday 27 November between 7pm and 6am, weather permitting. Access into and out of Gerringong will be via Belinda Street. Outside of this night time work, the Fern Street intersection at the highway will be open to traffic.

Night work at Belinda Street previously scheduled for Wednesday 26 November will now take place on **Friday 5 December 2014**. This will involve finalising pavement works for the drainage improvements on Belinda Street.

This work will take place at night between 8pm and 5am, weather permitting, to minimise the impact on motorists. Motorists are advised to follow all temporary signage, speed limits and traffic control measures.
