Princes Highway, Gerringong upgrade

During June 2014 (weather permitting) there will be changed traffic conditions at the Belinda Street and Fern Street intersections with the Princes Highway.

This includes temporary night time road closures.

Intersection of the Princes Highway and Belinda Street

There will be no access to or from the Princes Highway onto Belinda Street each night from Monday 2 June to Thursday 5 June (weather permitting) between 8pm and 5am. This is to progress building of the new interchange at Belinda Street.

Access into and out of Gerringong will be via Fern Street. Northbound motorists should use the Rose Valley Road u-turn bay to access Fern Street.

Outside of the night closures Belinda Street will be returned to one lane in each direction. A reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place.

We expect motorists will be able to travel underneath the new Belinda Street interchange to access the Princes Highway in July (weather permitting). This will replace the current intersection arrangements.

Intersection of the Princes Highway and Fern Street

There will be no access to or from the Princes Highway onto Fern Street each night from Tuesday 10 June to Thursday 12 June (weather permitting) between 7pm and 6am. This is to progress building the Fern Street bridge.

Access into and out of Gerringong will be via Belinda Street. Outside of the night time work the Fern Street intersection will be open to traffic.

From 10 June (weather permitting) motorists travelling south on the Princes Highway will also be moved onto a temporary section of road to the east of the existing highway.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to help guide motorists during both changes.

There may be some noise associated with these activities. The work will be carried out in accordance with the Roads and Maritime Services' Environmental Noise Manual.

There will be more traffic changes at both of these intersections as building progresses. Further information will be provided closer to the time.
