Re: Princes Highway, Gerringong upgrade – proposed closure of the shared path (for pedestrians and bicycle users) at Fern Street, Gerringong

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) is upgrading the Princes Highway between Mount Pleasant and Toolijooa Road.

As part of the highway upgrade, the project team will relocate the water main and construct a temporary vehicle side track and support structures for the new Fern Street railway overbridge. Construction of the temporary vehicle side track will ensure traffic flow is maintained during construction of the Fern Street railway overbridge.

To facilitate this work it is proposed to temporarily close the shared path (north of Sandy Wha Road) on Fern Street, Gerringong from 7 November 2012 until late 2013. Pedestrian access to Werri Lagoon will be via Sandy Wha Road and Renfrew Street. Please refer to the map on the back page for location of proposed closure and detour.

A shared path will be reinstated in the vicinity of the existing path after construction in the area is complete.

You are encouraged to provide feedback on the proposed closure until **24 October 2012**.

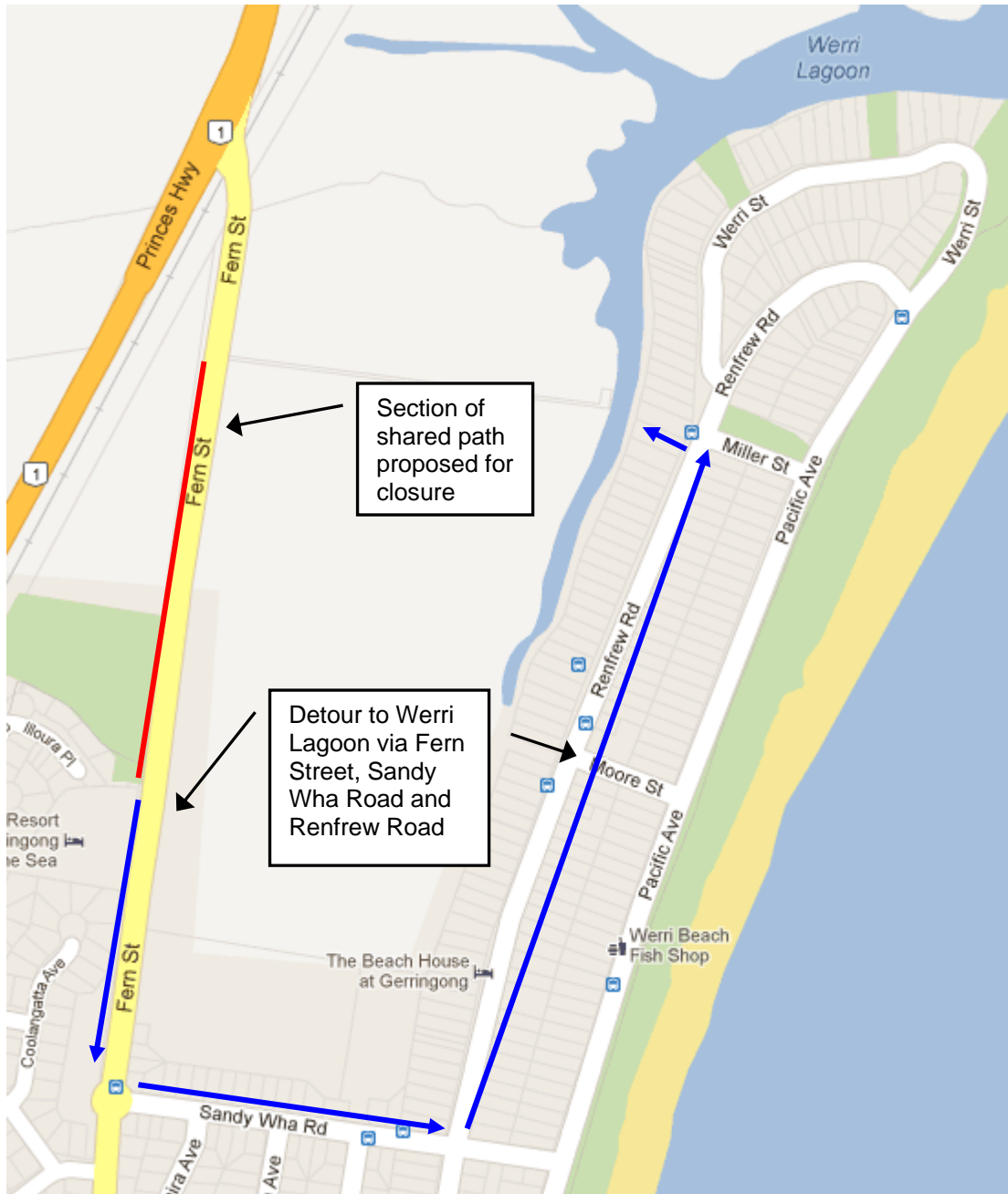
