Re: Gerringong upgrade out of hours work on the Princes Highway between Fern Street and Sims Road.

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) is upgrading the Princes Highway between Mount Pleasant and Toolijooa Road.

As part of this upgrade, out of hours work is required to install concrete barriers along the Princes Highway from Fern Street to north of Sims Road, Gerringong. These barriers will be installed around the work site to protect motorists, pedestrians and workers. The activity may involve light vehicles, a semi-trailer and a crane.

To minimise the impact on motorists the work will take place at night from **Monday 17 September to Thursday 4 October 2012, between 8pm and 4am**, weather permitting. During this period no night work will take place on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays.

During the work temporary closures of the Princes Highway northbound lane are required. A reduced speed limit of 40km/h, traffic management and advanced signage will be in place to help direct motorists.
