Proposed concept design

The NSW Government has committed to plan the duplication of the section of Goonoo Goonoo Road between Jack Smyth Drive and Calala Lane. The concept design for the proposed project is outlined in this community update.

Transport for NSW would like feedback from the community about the concept design, with all feedback being considered as the design and the project progresses.

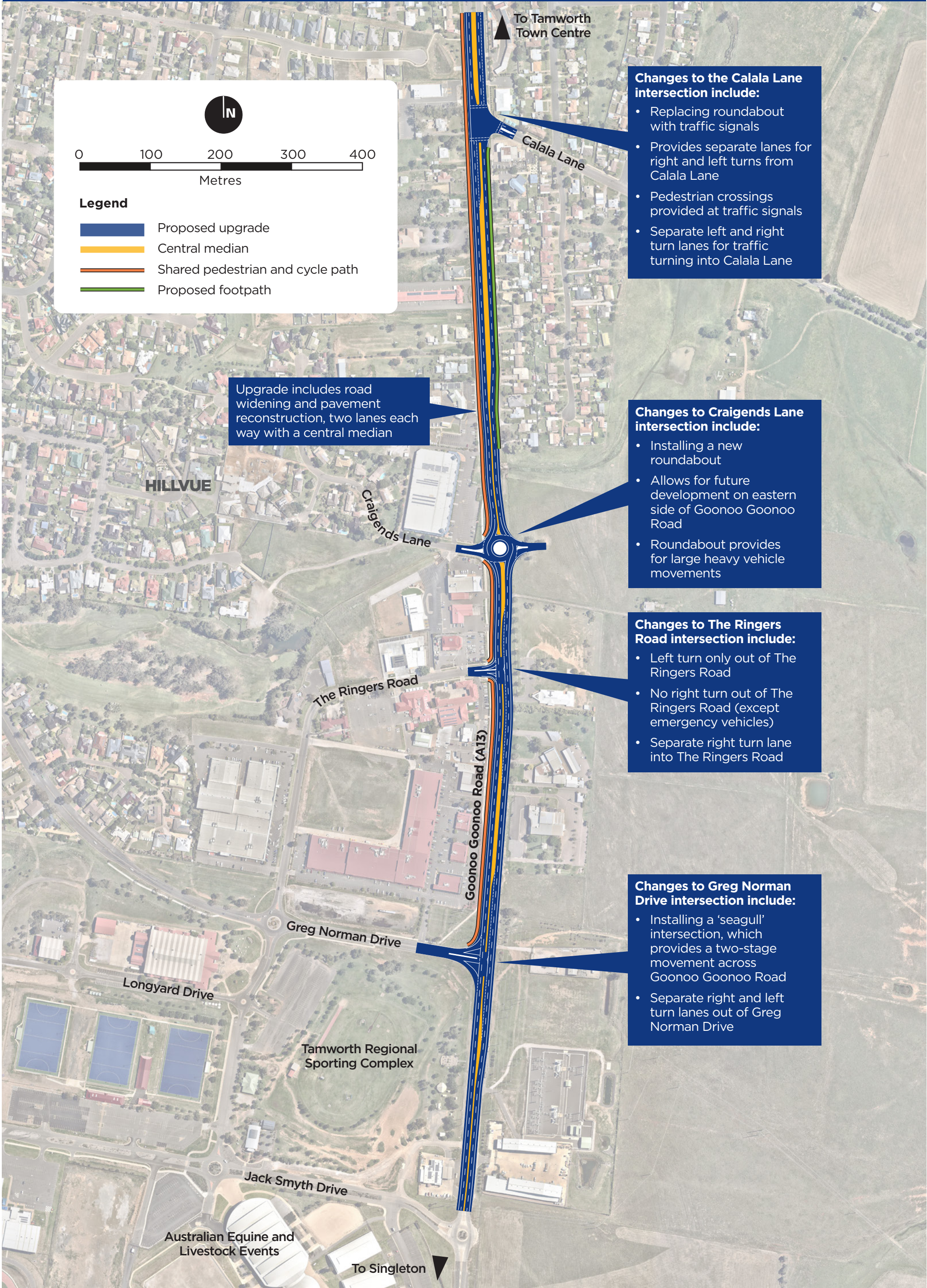

Goonoo Goonoo Road improvements



Background

Goonoo Goonoo Road is an important part of the Tamworth road network, providing a gateway to the city's entertainment and equestrian precinct, and is a vital link between the regional city and its surrounding towns and villages. Transport and Tamworth Regional Council have carried out investigations, including traffic modelling, over the past two years to assess the performance of this section of road.

These investigations have shown this section of road is not as safe as other similar roads in NSW. The NSW Government is currently funding planning work for the eventual duplication of this section of Goonoo Goonoo Road. The timing of construction is not known, and is dependent on funding availability.

Proposed improvements

The concept design includes:

- Duplicating Goonoo Goonoo Road between Jack Smyth Drive and Calala Lane
- Installing a set of traffic signals at the intersection of Goonoo Goonoo Road and Calala Lane
- Installing a roundabout at the intersection of Goonoo Goonoo Road and Craigends Lane
- Intersection improvements at the intersections of Goonoo Goonoo Road with The Ringers Road and Greg Norman Drive
- Installing a central median to separate oncoming traffic
- Improving pedestrian and cycle facilities

The improvements will increase capacity, improve safety, and provide a road transport network which supports development and facilitates access to regional growth centres.

Improving safety and capacity along the highway is important because over 20,000 vehicles use this section of the highway every day.
