

## Night work on the Great Western Highway between Hartley and Lithgow on Thursday, 19 January

The NSW Government is funding important safety upgrades on the Great Western Highway between Hartley and Lithgow.

Work includes replacing safety guardrails and will take place at several locations between Hartley and Lithgow. We have included maps to show the location of work.

To minimise disruption to traffic, the work will take place at night and will be carried out **Thursday 19 January** from **7pm** to **6am**. The work is expected to take **one night** to complete, weather permitting.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve machinery which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise this by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

### Traffic changes

Traffic control, lane closures, a reduced speed limit of 40km/h and intermittent stopping will be in place during work hours at all locations and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.

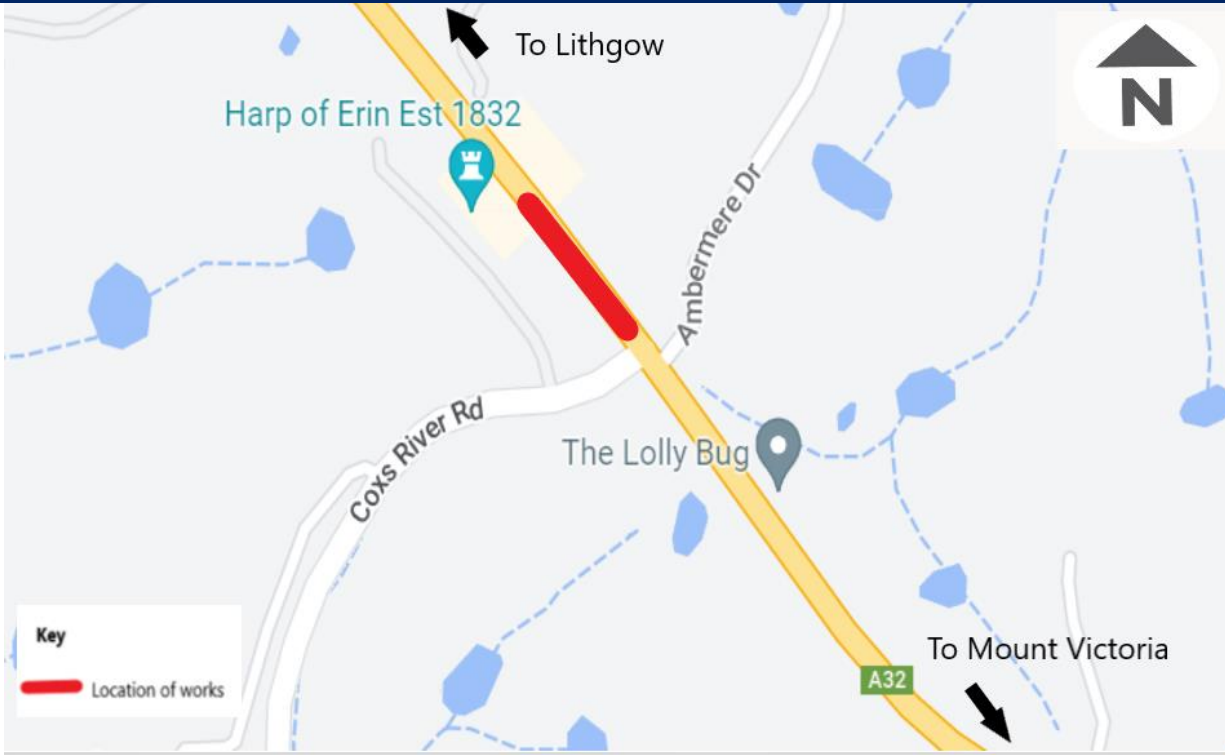
