


Safety Upgrade works, Medlow Bath, from Wednesday 5 May

The NSW and Federal Governments are carrying out this essential work to the intersection of the Great Western Highway with Bellevue Crescent and Foy Avenue to improve safety and efficiency.



Transport for NSW is carrying out the work, which includes the sealing and placement of asphalt, line marking and installation of the guard rail. The map above shows the area of the work, highlighted in blue.

Recently completed work at the intersections includes the removal of temporary barrier and preparation work for the new pavement, as well as removing the no right turn restriction at the intersection of Bellevue Crescent and the Great Western Highway.

Work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm Monday** to **Friday** and is expected to be completed in **four weeks**, weather permitting.

Some of our work needs to be carried out at night for the safety of our workers and motorists

There will be up to **seven** shifts of night work between 8pm and 5am from **10 May** to **24 May**, weather permitting.

We will notify you in advance if we need to do any work outside of these hours.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and ensuring lights do not shine onto homes.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Traffic control, single lane closures, intermittent stopping and reduced speed limits will be in place for the safety of motorists and workers.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions, allow extra time and follow the direction of signs and traffic control.
