



Changed traffic conditions on the Great Western Highway for essential maintenance

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work on the Great Western Highway at Raglan, east of Bathurst, from Monday 16 August.



Transport for NSW will carry out heavy patching work to improve the road surface and increase safety. The above map shows the location of works.

This work is expected to take **5 days** to complete, from **Monday 16 August**, weather permitting.

Work will take place from **Monday** to **Friday** between **7am** and **6pm**.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

Traffic control, single lane closures with intermittent stopping and reduced speed limits will be in place for the safety of motorists and workers. Motorists are advised to allow for an additional five to ten minutes travel time.
