

Traffic switch on the Great Western Highway at Raglan from November 29

The NSW Government is investing \$73 million to upgrade the Great Western Highway between Kelso and Raglan near Bathurst.

From Tuesday 29 November traffic on the Great Western Highway between PJ Moodie Memorial Drive and Nile Street will be moved onto the newly constructed road. We have included a map to show the change.

This configuration will be in place for three weeks. The switch will then be extended to Napoleon Street on Thursday 15 December, completing a one kilometre switch.

To facilitate this switch, asphaltting night work will be extended until Friday 2 December. Works will be carried out between 7pm and 6am, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

Traffic switch:

The existing westbound lane will remain open for residents to access their properties between Eugenie and Nile Street in one direction. Residents will need to turn into Eugenie Street and make a U-turn to turn left out of Eugenie Street and continue along the old road.

Residents will re-enter the highway from Nile Street.

Night work:

The work will involve machinery which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise this completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Access will be provided to properties and emergency vehicles.

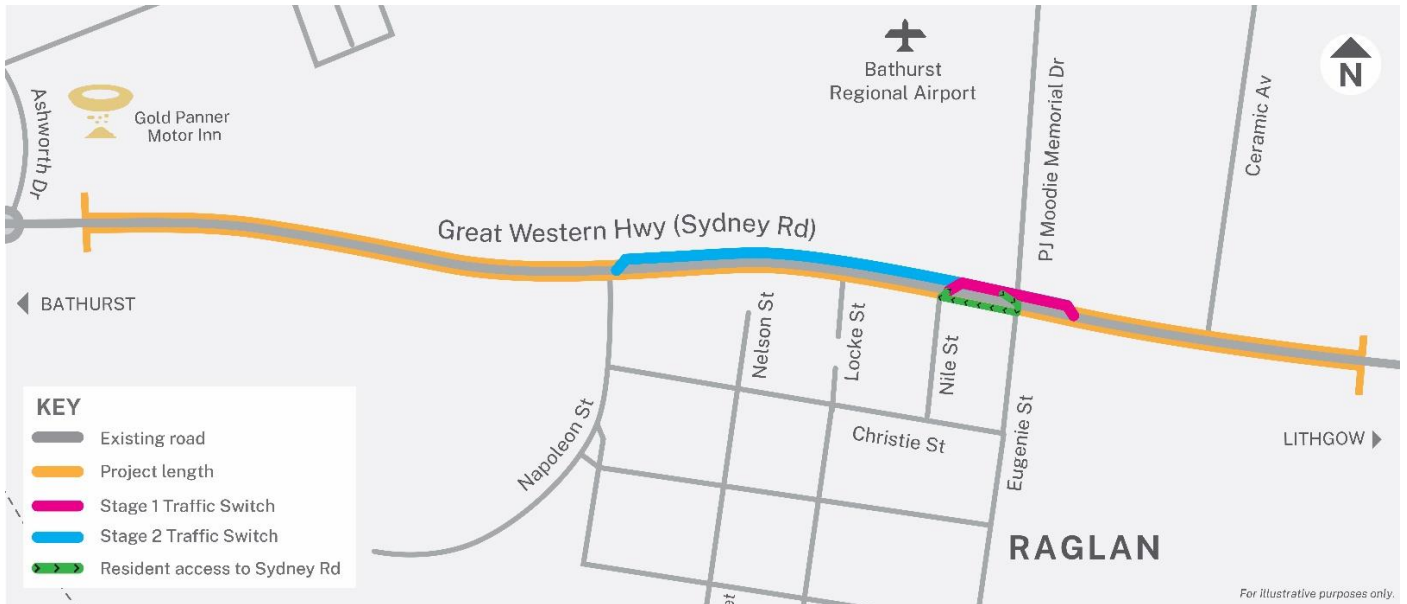
We will be in touch with residents prior to the extension of the switch on 15 December.

Traffic changes

Traffic control and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.
