## Utility relocation work at Little Hartley from Thursday 1 December

Together, the Australian Government and the NSW Government are investing more than \$4.5 billion towards upgrading the Great Western Highway between Katoomba and Lithgow.

Transport for NSW (Transport) will be carrying out utility relocation work at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade early works program, as part of the Great Western Highway Upgrade Program.

Contractors for Transport will carry out the work, which will include electrical and communication utility relocations in the Great Western Highway road corridor, near the intersections of Coxs River Road, Baaners Lane and Browns Gap Road, and on some private properties. We will contact property owners directly to request access if it is required. We have provided a map to show the approximate work area..

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Thursday 1 December 2022** to **Friday 31 March 2023**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

### How will the work affect you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on local residents.

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

We will continue to keep you informed as planning on the project progresses.

### Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Traffic control will be in place including temporary lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 60km/h on the Great Western Highway and 40km/h on Coxs River Road, Baaners Lane and Browns Gap Road when required.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
