



Survey investigations from Little Hartley to Hartley from 29 August

Together, the Australian Government and NSW Government have committed more than \$2.5 billion towards the East and West sections of the Great Western Highway Upgrade, between Katoomba and Blackheath, and between Little Hartley and Lithgow, respectively.

Transport for NSW will be carrying out survey work to inform the Coxs River Road Upgrade early works, as part of the Great Western Highway Upgrade Program.

The work will include a survey team locating and identifying existing survey marks between Little Hartley and Hartley. The work will occur in the road corridor and on some private properties next to the Great Western Highway, Coxs River Road and Baaners Lane. We will contact property owners directly to request access if it is required. The approximate investigation area is included in the map attached.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday** and expect to complete the work **between Monday 29 August and Friday 30 September**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on local residents. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off vehicles when not in use.

We will continue to keep you informed as planning on the project progresses.

Traffic changes

Traffic control may be in place where necessary for investigation work, with reduced speed limits of 40km/h and temporary lane closures.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
