Sutton Park rest area closed for two weeks from Monday 25 March

Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading the Great Western Highway between Katoomba and Lithgow to improve traffic flow, safety and travel conditions.

Major work is continuing at Blackheath. To complete the construction of the new access to the Sutton Park rest area, south of Blackheath, the rest area will be closed for two weeks from **25 March 2019**.

Rest areas at Neate Park in Blackheath for westbound traffic, and Bulls Camp at Woodford for eastbound traffic will remain available while the Sutton Park rest area is closed for the work.

Work at the rest area will involve digging in the road, footpath and road reserve and building the new road surface leading to the highway.

Electronic signs will be in place along the Great Western Highway to notify motorists.

Traffic control will ensure the safety of workers and the community while we are working. Pedestrians will still have access in this area.
