The NSW Government is upgrading Greenwich Point Wharf as part of the Transport Access Program. An initiative to deliver modern, safe and accessible transport infrastructure across the state.

Submissions Report now available and planning approval received

In December 2021, Transport for NSW invited the community and stakeholders to have their say on the Review of Environmental Factors (REF). Thank you to everyone who provided feedback during this time. Planning approval has been received and Transport for NSW is proceeding with plans to upgrade Greenwich Point Wharf.

Key feedback topics

The key feedback topics raised during public display included:

- feedback, suggestions and concerns relating to the proposed design, including current configuration, length of the jetty, adequacy of weather protection and design alternatives
- wharf closure during construction and alternative transport options
- visual impacts of the new wharf including the lift structure and size of the wharf.

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Design update and investigations

Your feedback is important to us. In response, we are investigating alternative transport arrangements while the wharf is closed for construction.

We are also investigating the following during detailed design:





- opportunities to reduce the lift height
- opportunities to reduce the length of the jetty
- additional weather protection
- different lift façades
- installation of berthing infrastructure to support berthing by vessels of different sizes.

The outcomes of these investigations will be confirmed before construction begins.

Next steps

Major construction is expected to begin in mid 2023 and take about six months to complete (weather permitting). We will notify the community before starting work.
