Haberfield, Ashfield and Leichhardt local network improvements





Thank you for your valuable feedback on our early Haberfield, Ashfield and Leichhardt local road network improvement proposals released in April 2020. We appreciate the time you took to speak to us, join our webinars and submit your comments.

You have given us a lot of valuable feedback to review and consider as we continue to develop these proposals. We received over 3,300 submissions from the community and stakeholders during the exhibition from 23 April to 24 May. Since this time we have been reviewing and considering all your feedback.

We had initially planned to have a Consultation Report ready to share with you mid-2020.

Due to the large volume of submissions we received, we have needed extra time to consider and respond to the concerns you have raised. Based on your feedback, we're also investigating potential changes

to the design. As a result, we're now planning to have a Consultation Report ready to share with you in September.

What's in the Consultation Report?

The Consultation Report will include:

- An overview of the consultation we have carried out on these proposals
- The issues raised during consultation
- Our response to the feedback raised
- An explanation of how the proposals have changed in response to your feedback; and
- Future opportunities to provide your feedback on the proposals.

We'll contact you in September when the Consultation Report is ready. We'll also hold a webinar and have more information available on our online portal to help you understand the new information.

Upcoming investigations

From mid August we will need to carry out some investigations as part of the development of the designs and environmental assessment process. The investigations will be carried out in the proposal areas and work will include:

- Geotechnical investigations
- Pavement and utility investigations
- Noise monitoring
- Socio-economic impact assessment.

We will notify nearby residents and businesses before the investigations start.
