

Heathcote Road Bridge upgrade

Heathcote Road closures

Transport for NSW | April 2022

Work is now underway on the Heathcote Road Bridge upgrade, with the project expected to be complete within 12 months.

To build the road approaches to the new bridge we will be excavating and widening the existing rock cutting. To undertake this work safely and minimise traffic impacts on road users during the day there will be full road closures of Heathcote Road between New Illawarra Road and Princes Highway, on weeknights and over weekends.

Throughout the construction period, occasional **weeknight closures** of Heathcote Road will be required. These are expected to start in **May 2022**, and will be between 8pm and 5am, weather permitting.

Weekend closures are expected to start in **early June 2022**, between 8pm Friday and 5am Monday, weather permitting. During weekend closures, construction will occur for 24 hours per day to reduce the need for set up and pack down, and reduce the number of closures needed overall to safely deliver the project.

The community will be notified of the closure dates closer to the time.

What will be happening?

During these full closures we will be excavating and widening the existing rock cutting, building the road approaches to the bridges and delivering and installing bridge girders.

Weeknight closures will be ongoing until the project is complete. We will work to minimise closures where possible.

We expect there will be **approximately eight weekend closures** between June and September 2022 to safely complete this work.

Access to Forum Drive will be maintained during the road closures.

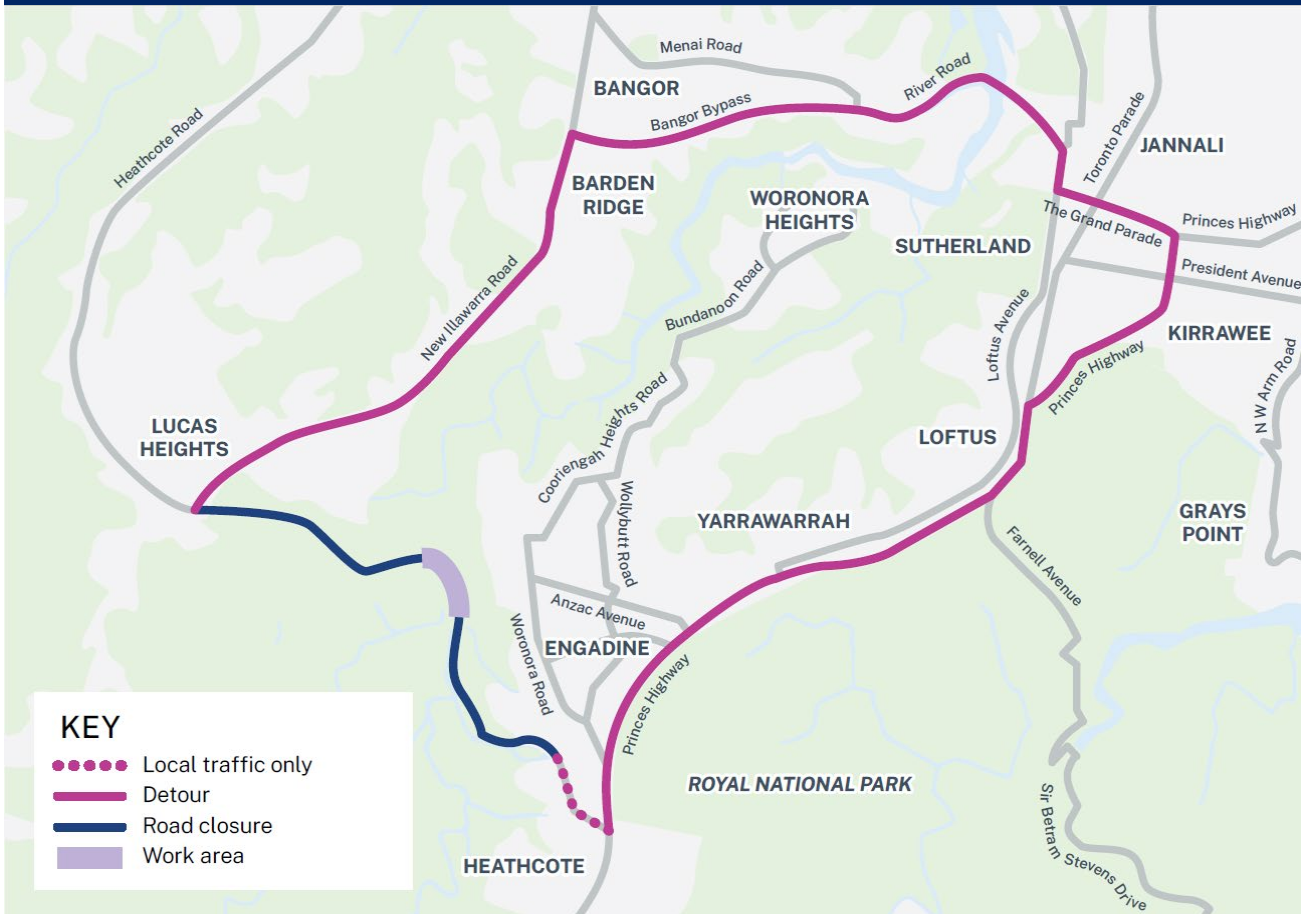
National Parks and Wildlife Services, emergency services and pedestrian access to Pipeline Trail and Scouters Mountain Trail will also be maintained during the road closures.

Detour

During the weeknight and weekend closures of Heathcote Road between New Illawarra Road and the Princes Highway a detour will be in place via Kirrawee and the Bangor Bypass.

Heathcote Road closure - Detour



The detour is suitable for freight and B-double trucks up to 26 metres long.

The detour may add up to 30 minutes to your journey so please allow additional travel time and plan your journey.

Electronic messages signs will advise closure dates in advance and the detour will be clearly signposted.
