Heathcote Road will be closed **three nights a week, Monday to Wednesday from 20 July 2020 to 5 August 2020**, as Transport for NSW undertakes important bridge safety investigation works.

Detour via Bangor Bypass

To safely carry out the works, Heathcote road will be closed to traffic between the intersection of Princes Highway and New Illawarra Road.

What works will be carried out?

We will be carrying out:

Mobile laser survey scanning and ground surveying through the approach and length of the bridge.

Road pavement boring and coring works to confirm ground conditions.

Geotechnical surveying.

Utility testing.

We will be on site for up to nine nights over this three-week period. While most investigation works will take place in the first two weeks, the final week will be reserved for any work that crops up due to unforeseen circumstances, including inclement weather.

Please follow the road signs and keep to speed limits for your safety.

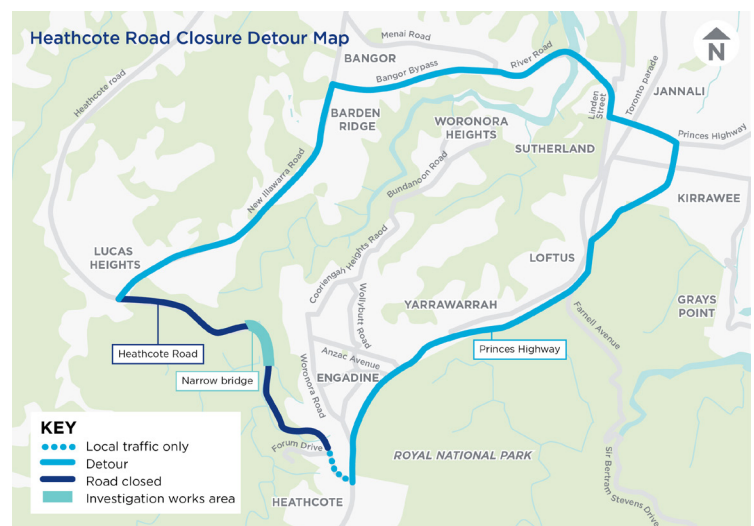
