Day and night work for Heathcote Road Upgrade between Infantry Parade, Holsworthy and the Avenue, Voyager Point from Monday 22 November, 2021

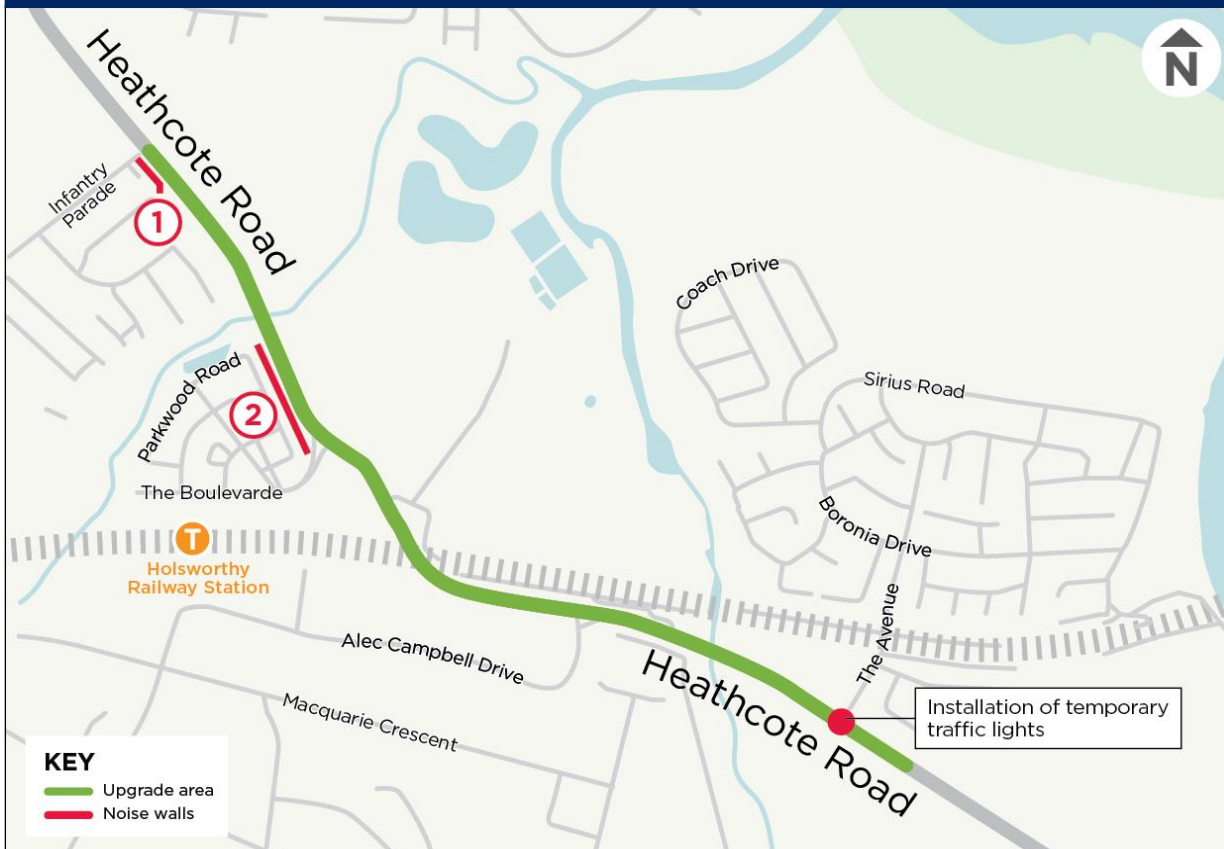
The NSW Government is upgrading the 2.2 kilometre section of Heathcote Road between Infantry Parade, Holsworthy and The Avenue, Voyager Point to help reduce congestion, improve road safety and provide more reliable journeys for all road users.

From Monday 22 November we will start work to install traffic lights at the intersection of Heathcote Road and The Avenue, Voyager Point to improve safety. This is the first stage of our work on Heathcote Road.

We will carry out this work during day and night. Our activities will include:

- Installing traffic controls such as barriers and signs
- Installing environmental controls
- Removing some trees and vegetation on The Avenue
- Under boring the electrical wiring for traffic lights
- Asphaltting, installing traffic lights and line marking.

Our work schedule

We will start work from **22 November**. Our standard work hours will be from **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm** and **Saturday 8am to 1pm**.

Night work will be carried out over 18 nights from Monday 22 November 2021 to Thursday 23 December 2021 between 8pm and 5am.

During our night work, we will work up to four nights per week between Monday and Sunday from 8pm to 5am. We will generally work two nights, one night off and then work two more nights, weather permitting.

We will continue to update the community about our work schedule.

How will the work affect you?

Some of the work will be noisy. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place around the work zone during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow extra travel time during this work.

Electronic signs will advise road users about the traffic changes. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
