



Works continuing along Heathcote Road

The Australian and NSW Governments are upgrading Heathcote Road between MacArthur Drive, Holsworthy, and The Avenue, Voyager Point to help reduce congestion, improve road safety, and provide more reliable journeys for all road users.

In June and July 2022, we will continue weekend and night works. The upcoming out of hours work (OOHW) will occur over four-night shifts per week but only two consecutive nights in the same area, weather permitting. This OOHW also includes some weekend work on **16 and 17 July** during a Sydney Trains planned trackwork period. Construction hours are between **6pm to 7am Monday to Sunday**.

What to expect

Our work activities will include:

- Installing temporary traffic controls and signs between MacArthur Drive and The Avenue
- Clearing vegetation
- Installing additional concrete safety barriers
- Undertaking utility investigations (potholing) and relocations
- Removing existing asphalt and concrete pavement
- Excavation and installing watermain
- Removing existing concrete median/kerb
- Constructing temporary pavements at various locations over the 2.2 km of Heathcote Road.

This work will be noisy at times. However, wherever possible measures to reduce noise will be implemented including turning equipment off when not in use, positioning equipment as far away from residences as possible, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and completing the noisiest work before midnight.

Equipment to be used

Equipment to be used includes generators, forklift, excavators, trucks, compressors, street sweeper, powered hand tools and lighting towers

Pedestrian detour

As part of the upgrade works, the footpath along Heathcote Road between Infantry Parade and Macarthur Drive is now closed until June 2023.

A temporary pedestrian detour is now established between Infantry Parade and Holsworthy Station. The detour will be marked with signage to guide pedestrians along the alternate pathway. This will ensure works along Heathcote Road can safely continue with pedestrians away from the construction area.
