



Works continuing along Heathcote Road

The Australian and NSW Governments are upgrading Heathcote Road between Infantry Parade, Holsworthy, and The Avenue, Voyager Point to help reduce congestion, improve road safety, and provide more reliable journeys for all road users.

In August 2022, we will continue weekend and night works. The upcoming out of hours work (OOHW) will occur over four-night shifts per week but only two consecutive nights in the same area, weather permitting. Out of hours work also includes some night work between **15 to 19 August** and weekend work on **27 and 28 August** during Sydney Trains planned trackwork periods. Construction hours are between **6pm to 7am Monday to Sunday**.

What to expect

Our work activities will include:

- Clearing vegetation, including tree removal which will be chipped and recycled
- Undertaking utility adjustment works including potholing, trenching and relocations
- Removing existing asphalt and concrete pavement, medians, and kerbs
- Constructing temporary pavements at various locations over the 2.2 km of Heathcote Road.
- Piling, demolition, and other works associated with the road bridge over the T8 Airport and South Line.
- Piling works associated with the utility bridge over Harris Creek.
- General earthworks

This work will be noisy at times. However, wherever possible measures to reduce noise will be implemented including turning equipment off when not in use, positioning equipment as far away from residences as possible, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and completing the noisiest work before midnight. Where these impacts are the greatest, residents will be contacted directly about respite offers where appropriate.

Harris Creek bridge

Three bridge upgrades that are part of our work are Harris Creek bridge, Williams Creek bridge and the T8 Airport railway line road bridge.

The first stage of our work included vegetation removal and earthworks at Harris Creek.

We are now completing piling works associated with the utility bridge over Harris Creek. Pedestrian detours remain in place, whilst this work occurs. For more information, and for a map of the detour, visit nswroads.work/heathcoteroad.
