

Continuation of work on Heathcote Road

Transport for NSW | February 2023

The Australian and NSW Governments are upgrading Heathcote Road between Infantry Parade, Holsworthy, and The Avenue, Voyager Point to help reduce congestion, improve road safety, and provide more reliable journeys for all road users.

Work is continuing on the Heathcote Road Upgrade and over the following 8 weeks:

- utility adjustment works including potholing, trenching and relocations between Infantry Parade and The Avenue. This will include some disruptions from time to time to enable cutovers from existing services to new services. Affected customers will be notified of any planned outages by utility providers.
- removing existing asphalt, concrete pavement, medians, islands and kerbs between Infantry Parade and The Avenue
- constructing temporary pavements and line-marking at various locations over the 2.2 km of Heathcote Road
- pile foundation demolition, embankment and other works associated with the road bridge over the T8 Airport and South Line
- piling works associated with Williams Creek bridge, including installation of sheet piles and construction of piling platforms
- piling works associated with Harris Creek Eastbound bridge, including installation of sheet piles and construction of piling platforms
- general earthworks
- barrier relocation, barrier installation, line marking and asphaltting between Infantry Parade and The Avenue
- installation of stormwater drainage.

Our work schedule

Our standard work hours are **Monday to Friday** from **7am to 6pm** and **Saturday** from **8am to 1pm**.

Out of hours work

Night work is required between **Wednesday 1 February** and **Tuesday 28 February 2023**, weather permitting. Work will include utility and barrier relocation, line marking, drainage, and asphaltting between Infantry Parade and The Avenue. Embankment works and installation of sheet piles at the road bridge over the T8 Airport and South Line will be done during Sydney Trains planned trackwork period between **Saturday 18 February to Sunday 19 February 2023**.

We will work over five-night shifts per week but only **two consecutive nights in the same area**, weather permitting. Construction hours are between **6pm to 7am Monday to Sunday**. We will notify impacted residents prior to any out of hours work taking place.

How this work will affect you

We need to carry out this work at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and road users.

The **out of hours work** will be noisy at times, however we will make every effort to minimise the impact for residents by carrying out noisier work before midnight, turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and directing lights away from properties where possible. Where these impacts are the greatest, residents will be contacted directly about respite offers where appropriate.

Equipment used may include generators, excavators, pilling rig, rollers, street sweeper, trucks, concrete trucks and pumps, powered hand tools, underbore machine, water cart, and lighting towers.
