



Road work on Newell Highway at Daroobalgie, near Forbes from Monday 8 March

The NSW Government is carrying out this essential work as part of its ongoing commitment to road safety and managing heavy vehicle compliance.



Transport for NSW is upgrading the Daroobalgie heavy vehicle inspection bays, which includes installation of new weather proof inspection sheds and site offices. This project will provide a safer working environment for our compliance inspectors to monitor heavy vehicle movement on the Newell Highway, and to help address ongoing road safety issues. The map above shows the location of the work. Work in this location will not impact traffic on the Newell Highway.

We will be on site for 30 day shifts and 30 night shifts between Monday 8 March and Friday 23 April, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between 7am and 6pm and 9pm and 5am, Monday to Friday and 7am and 6pm and 9pm and 5am on Saturday and Sunday.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How this work will affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work, however both worksites are a significant distance from residential areas.

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There may be temporary traffic changes at times to ensure the work zone is safe. Temporary traffic management will be in place at times to allow vehicles to enter and exit site.

Work in this location will not impact traffic on the Newell Highway.
