

## Start of work on Henry Lawson Drive upgrade, Georges Hall from Monday 15 November

The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its \$450 million Urban Roads Pinch Point Program which aims to ease congestion and improve journey reliability on Sydney's key road corridors.

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) will be upgrading Henry Lawson Drive (HLD) between Beale Street and just south of Rabaul Road in Georges Hall from **Monday 15 November 2021** with expected completion in **late 2022**. We consulted with the community on the upgrade in July 2020, listened to your feedback and adjusted the scope of the project.

### The Henry Lawson Drive upgrade features:

- an additional southbound lane between Beale Street and Rabaul Road
- a new pedestrian footpath on the eastern side between Rabaul Road and Haig Avenue
- banning the right turn from HLD onto Rabaul Road.

### When completed, the upgrade will:

- reduce northbound queuing on Henry Lawson Drive at Rabaul Road
- improve traffic flow in both directions along this section of Henry Lawson Drive
- improve road safety for all users.

Motorists who would turn right at Rabaul Road from Henry Lawson Drive can use the intersections with traffic signals either at Haig Avenue or Tower Road.



## What our work consists of

### Setting up the site compound within Kentucky Reserve

We will set up a temporary site compound within Kentucky Reserve on Henry Lawson Drive to store materials and equipment, and provide amenity sheds and parking for site vehicles. This location was chosen because it is near the project site and is vacant. TfNSW has all the planning and

environmental approvals necessary to establish the site compound at this location.

The site compound establishment work will include installing amenity sheds, laydown area for equipment and storage of materials, power to the compound and temporary fencing. Upon completion of the project, the site will be restored on a like-for-like basis.

### Start of work on Henry Lawson Drive

We will start work on the project from **Monday 15 November 2021** and will keep the community informed every three months on the progress of our work. In the next three months our work will include:

- survey works
- tree trimming and some tree removal
- utilities and road pavement investigations
- set up work sites and traffic arrangements

### Our work hours

Our **daytime** work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Sunday** and **night time** hours from **8pm to 5am** the next day, from **Sunday to Thursday**, weather and worksite conditions permitting. These working hours are in line with existing COVID-19 public health orders. We will notify you of any changes to our work schedule.

### How will the work affect you?

There will be increased vehicle movements at Rabaul Road's access to Kentucky Reserve whilst we set up and use the site compound. Community access to the reserve and the car park will be maintained during our work.

There will be disruptions during our work. When we can, we will work during the day. However, we will need to carry out work at night. We will do what we can to reduce noise disturbance to the community. During night work, we will complete noisier tasks by midnight, direct lights away from neighbours where possible, ensure vehicles and equipment are turned off when not in use and require workers to be considerate of neighbours.

Our work is in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-19 Safe plan is in place, including masks and QR codes.

### Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures while we work to ensure the safety of road users and workers. There may also be partial closure of footpaths in our work areas and alternative paths will be provided. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller directions.
