Utility investigation work on Hill Road, Lidcombe, from Monday, 1 May

The NSW Government is investigating a westbound off ramp from the M4 to Hill Road, Lidcombe, to support the development growth around Carter Street and Hill Road, and improve traffic efficiency, accessibility and enhance road safety for all road users.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out investigation work to locate underground utilities, which includes drilling potholes and digging trenches on either side of the footpath on the western side of Hill Road, Lidcombe.

There will be up to **four night shifts** of night work from **Monday**, **1 May**, to **Monday**, **8 May**, **2017**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **9pm** to **5am**.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy, but we will make every effort to minimise its impact including organising work to allow opportunities for respite. Portable lighting will be used and we will focus lights only on the working area, however there may be some spill-over of light into some nearby residences.

Access to properties in the work zone may be affected during working hours. Work that takes place in front of properties will be of a temporary nature and Roads and Maritime will contact impacted property owners to discuss their access requirements and will make every effort to avoid blocking driveways. In the unlikely case where a driveway is blocked when access is required, please speak to the person on-site carrying out the work or contact our Project Manager, Steven Bywater, on 1800 792 086.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. A single west bound lane closure will be in place during night work and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the existing footpath at all times during the work.
