

Field investigations on Hillsborough Road, Hillsborough from Monday 20 July

Transport for NSW is carrying out investigations near the intersection of Chadwick Street and Hillsborough Road to inform future road work.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which involves geotechnical sampling and testing by drilling and removing samples at intermittent locations along the road.

We will be working between **7pm** and **5am** from **Monday** to **Thursday** and expect to complete the work in **six nights**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise and lighting impacts. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages along the road and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. We will also direct lighting away from houses wherever possible.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit may be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
