
# **Community**Update





**MAY 2015** 



Hornsby Quarry is located west of Hornsby town centre and next to Berowra Valley National Park. Roads and Maritime Services is proposing to handle, manage and beneficially reuse spoil from NorthConnex at Hornsby Quarry. Reusing spoil from NorthConnex at Hornsby Quarry is an environmentally sustainable use for the spoil. It would also assist Hornsby Shire Council with their plans to rehabilitate the site for public recreation and community benefit.

This \$22 million project would be funded by the NSW and Federal governments and Hornsby Shire Council. The Lend Lease Bouygues Joint Venture (LLBJV) would deliver the project. It is expected to start at the end of 2015 and finish in mid-2018, weather permitting.

#### **Key features**

The project would manage and reuse spoil from the construction of NorthConnex. This would involve:


- Establishing the site
- Hauling spoil by truck from NorthConnex to Hornsby Quarry
- Stockpiling the spoil
- Placing soil in the Hornsby Quarry void (the area where rock has been removed from the quarry in the past) using a conveyor
- Demobilising and rehabilitating the site.

Once this project is complete, Hornsby Shire Council will be able to rehabilitate the site and develop it for recreational purposes.



#### This project would rehabilitate the site by:

- Rehabilitating disturbed areas
- Removing security fencing and signage from the construction area and replacing security fencing around the quarry exclusion zone
- Reinstating public access to areas outside the exclusion zone including the mountain bike trails

#### **Project benefits**

While the Hornsby Quarry site is zoned for public recreation under the Hornsby Local Environmental Plan, the quarry itself is closed to the public for safety reasons. Council has opened the areas outside of the quarry safety exclusion zone for recreational activities including bushwalking and mountain biking. Reusing spoil from NorthConnex at Hornsby Quarry is an environmentally sustainable use for the spoil. It would also assist Hornsby Council with their plans to rehabilitate the site for public recreation and community benefit.



#### **Work hours**


Hauling spoil to the site and all work on site would be carried out between the following hours:

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday
- 8am to 1pm Saturdays

We will obtain approvals and notify you in advance if we need to work outside these times.

#### **Haulage routes**

The proposed haulage routes to and from Hornsby Quarry were developed in consultation with Hornsby Shire Council to minimise impacts on the community. These routes will be subject to further investigation as part of detailed design. Spoil would be transported to Hornsby Quarry from various NorthConnex construction locations. Empty trucks returning to NorthConnex construction sites would follow different routes depending on the time of the day. The proposed haulage routes are identified in the map below:



#### **Environmental Impact Statement**

Roads and Maritime is currently preparing an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). In the coming weeks we will send out more information to the community about how to view and comment on the EIS when it is exhibited by the Department of Planning and Environment in mid-2015. At the close of the exhibition period, Roads and Maritime will prepare a submissions report to document all issues raised during the formal submissions period and provide responses. The NSW Minister for Planning will determine whether to approve the project and any conditions to be applied.
