


Upgrading pinch point at Hoxton Park Road and Whitford Road, Hinchinbrook from Monday 15 July



The NSW Government is upgrading the intersection of Hoxton Park Road and Whitford Road in Hinchinbrook to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety.

Residents from Hinchinbrook and surrounding suburbs often experience congestion and long wait times at the Hoxton Park Road and Whitford Road intersection. Road users accessing the M7 or travelling west along Hoxton Park Road also experience delays because of congestion at this intersection.

To address this, Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work to widen Hoxton Park Road and Whitford Road to:

- create a second dedicated right turn lane from Hoxton Park Road onto Whitford Road improving traffic flow for local residents
- allow turning traffic to wait in dedicated lanes, rather than queuing along Hoxton Park Road, enabling westbound motorists to freely travel through the intersection.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to five day and five night shifts a week between July and October 2019, excluding public holidays.

For this upcoming work we will be on site for up to 45 night and 45 day shifts between Monday 15 July and Monday 14 October 2019, weather permitting.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday**. Our night hours will be between **8pm** and **6am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

Upcoming work

For this final stage, we will continue road work which includes adjusting traffic lights and utilities, upgrading stormwater drains, demolishing existing footpaths and asphalting.

We will continue to update you on this project as work progresses, including informing you in advance about future work schedules and night work.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities, like saw-cutting concrete, jack-hammering and breaking up concrete, by **midnight**.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures may be in place and will affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the directions of traffic controllers and signs.
