


Night work and traffic changes on Hoxton Park Road and Joadja Road from Monday 20 July

The NSW Government is upgrading the intersection of Hoxton Park Road and Joadja Road, Hoxton Park to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety.



Transport for NSW is continuing work to upgrade the intersection of Hoxton Park Road and Joadja Road, Hoxton Park. To ensure the safety of our workers and all road users, we will need to temporarily close part of Joadja Road and Hoxton Park Road for asphalting.

The closures will happen at night, and in two stages to minimise disruption. We will be on site the following nights:

Stage 1 closure

Hoxton Park Road westbound and Joadia Road southbound:

- Monday 20 July
- Tuesday 21 July
- Wednesday 22 July
- Thursday 23 July

Stage 2 closure

Hoxton Park Road eastbound and Joadia Road northbound:

- Thursday 23 July
- Sunday 26 July
- Monday 27 July

Our working hours during these night shifts will be between 8pm and 5am.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to six night shifts between Monday 20 July and Monday 27 **July**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between 8pm and 5am from Sunday to Friday.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise and disruption associated with this work including asphalting, jackhammering, concrete cutting and excavating.

We will make every effort to minimise noise and disruption by completing noisier tasks before midnight and using noise barriers where possible.

Residential acess will be maintained. There will be no disruption to local bus timetables.

Traffic changes

To ensure the work zone is safe, lane closures, road closures and detours will be in place and this may affect travel times. Clearly marked detours and traffic controllers will be in place to help road users complete their journeys.
