## Maintenance work for Brig O'Johnston Bridge at Clarence Town from 17 November

The NSW Government has provided funding for this essential maintenance work.

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Roads and Maritime Services will carry out maintenance work on the Brig O'Johnston Bridge from Monday 17 November to Friday 28 November to install additional supports under the deck near the abutment on the Clarence Town side of the bridge.

This work is not related to the rehabilitation proposal for Brig O'Johnston Bridge and is routine maintenance for the bridge.

The work will take approximately two weeks to complete and will involve maintenance under the deck near the abutment on the southern side of the bridge.

The work will require a work crew, light vehicles, a small mobile crane and traffic control. There will be some intermittent daytime road closures of up to 15 minutes, outside of peak periods.

### Ongoing consultation about plans to rehabilitate Brig O'Johnston Bridge

The NSW Government is funding the Brig O'Johnston Bridge upgrade as part of the \$145 million Bridges for the Bush program to improve road freight productivity in regional NSW and reduce timber bridge maintenance costs by replacing or upgrading bridges.

We held a community information session in Clarence Town on Saturday 25 October 2014 to speak to the community about planning for the rehabilitation of the historic Brig O'Johnston Bridge over the Williams River.

We are pleased with the level of interest in the community about the rehabilitation proposal and the information session was well attended.

We will continue to consult with the community about the rehabilitation proposal.
