Continued out of hours work on Martin Bridge, Taree, from Sunday 29 May

The NSW Government is investing in essential maintenance to preserve the structural integrity of Martin Bridge and to reduce future maintenance costs.

Transport for NSW and construction partner, Eptec, are continuing maintenance work on Martin Bridge.

Due to weather delays and continuing COVID-19 impacts on the work force, we are experiencing delays to completion of the repainting project. Work on Martin Bridge is now expected to be completed by the third quarter of 2022.

We thank you for your patience.

What are we doing?

We will be carrying out limited night work as part of the repainting work. Work is required outside normal project hours for the safety of workers and road users, and to minimise traffic delays.

Traffic on the bridge will be reduced to one lane during the work. Access to and from Taree will be maintained throughout the work with no detours required.

Work will be carried out from **Sunday 29 May.** We will be working from **Sunday to Thursday** between **7pm** and **5am** for **two weeks**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will carry out the noisiest work before 11pm and make every effort to minimise noise when possible throughout each shift including installing noise blankets and switching machinery off when not in use. We will also be using work methods which reduce noise as much as possible.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be place during night work and may affect travel time.
