

Work continuing on Old Mooney Mooney Creek Bridge on the Old Pacific Highway

The NSW Government is investing in this maintenance work to ensure continued safe operation of the bridge.

Roads and Maritime Services will continue to carry out the work, which includes repair to steel elements of the bridge and painting. The site compounds at both ends of the bridge will remain until the project is complete.

We will continue to work between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday** and expect to complete the work by **August**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

From Tuesday 12 February traffic control and a reduced speed limit to 40km/h will be in place and motorists may experience delays of up to 5 minutes.

Pedestrian access will be maintained. On occasion, the stairs next to the bridge which provide access to the Great North Walk may be temporarily obstructed and a member of the project team will be on site to escort pedestrians providing a safe passage around the work.
