

## Changes to the bridge opening schedule on Swansea Bridge, Swansea from Monday 19 April

The NSW Government is investing in essential maintenance to ensure continued safe and reliable operation of the bridge.

Transport for NSW will continue the rescheduled final stage of work which involves placing rock ballast over the newly installed sub-marine cables to prevent future erosion.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday**. Work is expected to be completed in **up to five shifts**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if work is required outside these times.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

### Bridge opening restrictions

From **Monday 19 April**, regular daily bridge openings will be reduced, to facilitate the work. The revised daily bridge opening times are provided overleaf.

### Traffic changes

Work will be carried out from a boat and barge positioned on the western side of the Swansea Bridge within the opening span. This will require closures of the opening span during work hours to facilitate the ballast work. Adjacent spans may also be closed to facilitate other work vessels being used. Channel closed markers with delineation will be in place advising vessel operators which channels are closed to ensure the work zone is safe.

There will be no impact for motorists travelling over the bridge. Out of hour openings may be required during this period to allow movement of the barge around the site.
