

# Work continuing on the Princes Highway between James Street and south of Torrens Street, Blakehurst

June 2021

Since our last update in March, we have continued work to upgrade the Princes Highway between James Street and south of Torrens Street at Blakehurst.

**Between April and June 2021 on the Princes Highway at Torrens Street and Church Street we have:**

- Continued utility adjustment works, moving pipes and cables to make way for the widened road
- Carried out bulk excavation on our property adjustments
- Relocated telegraph poles and street lights
- Imported recycled material to be used for the road widening



## Our next stage of work

Work on this project is progressing well. Between July and September 2021, we will:

- Continue utility investigation and relocation
- Remove trees
- Relocate the bus shelter in front of Todd Park
- Continue traffic signal works
- Continue property adjustment works



## Our work schedule

We will work up to **63 day shifts and 64 night shifts** between **Thursday 1 July and Wednesday 30 September**, weather permitting.

Our day work hours will be between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and Saturday between 8am and 1pm**. Our night work hours will be between **7pm to 5am, from Sunday to Thursday**.

We will not work during the day on Sundays, public holidays or during heavy rainfall. Thank you for your ongoing patience as we carry out this important work.

## Safe removal of asbestos containing material

Asbestos containing materials may be discovered in the ground in the project area as the project progresses. If we identify asbestos containing material, we will implement an asbestos management plan which details safe work practices and will ensure all work is managed to strict Environment Protection Authority requirements. There is no risk to nearby residents.

## How will the work affect you?

There will be noise and disruptions associated with our work. We will work with the community to minimise the impact. This includes mitigation measures to reduce the impact of noisier tasks (such as jackhammering and concrete saw cutting) by completing these tasks before **midnight**. We will inform you as work progresses and notify you of any changes to our work schedule.

## Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures in place while we work to ensure the work area is safe for road users and our workers. We may be required to temporarily close side streets, residential and emergency service access will be maintained at all times, and detours will be in place.

There may also be partial closure of footpaths in the work areas and clearly marked pedestrian detours will be provided. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller directions.
