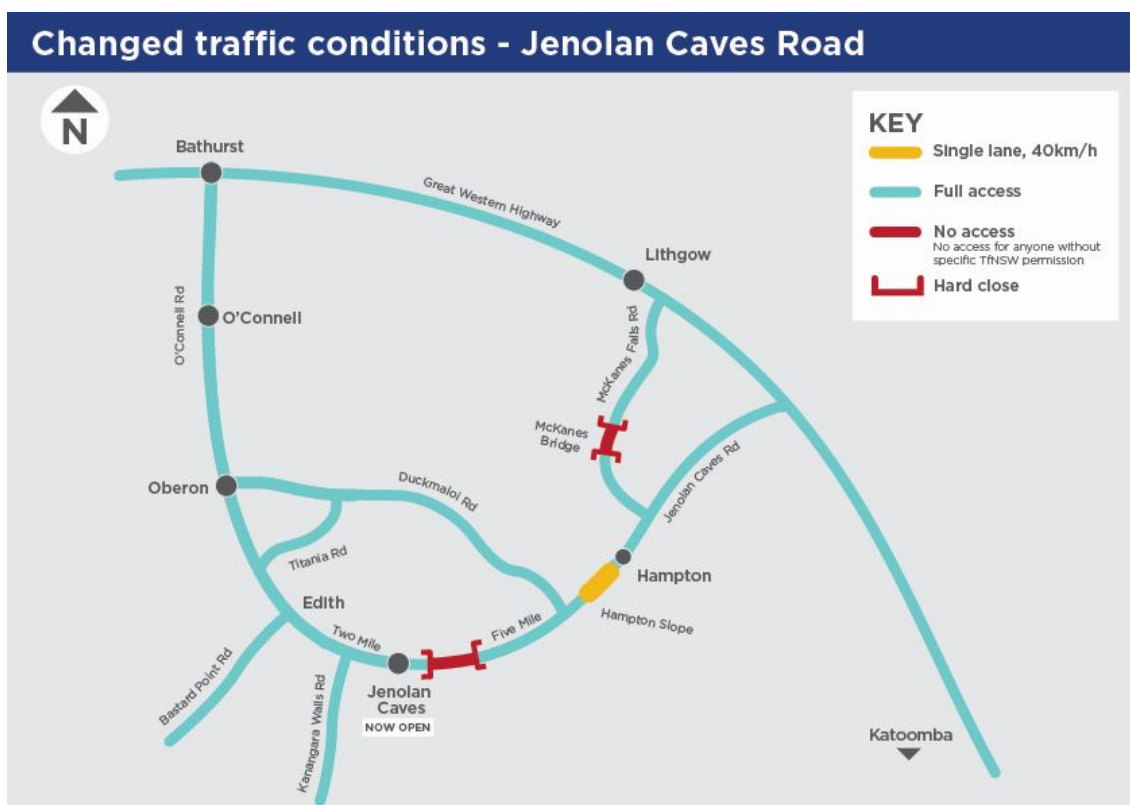


Transport for NSW advises that Jenolan Caves Road at Hampton will reopen to single lane traffic on Wednesday 26 May 2021. The NSW Government has committed all available resources to the clean-up and rehabilitation of this stretch of road and recognises the importance of re-establishing this vital link between Oberon and the Great Western Highway. Works have included scaling and removing loose material from the slope and road, installation of protective mesh, rock bolting and hydro-mulching.

While work to the downslope is continuing, traffic control including single lane closures and reduced speed limits of 40km/h will be in place for the foreseeable future and motorists are asked to stay informed via [Live Traffic](#).

As previously communicated, the impacts at Five Mile are complex and severe. A team of geotechnical engineers and specialists are currently carrying out investigations and working on a concept to rehabilitate this section of road however this section of road is expected to be closed for an extended period.
