
Jenolan Caves Road | 8 April 2021

Following the extreme weather event that resulted in a number of closures around the Jenolan Caves precinct, Transport for NSW is prioritising the extensive clean-up efforts and repairs to these roads. Assessments have now been completed and the following provides the latest update and timelines for Jenolan Caves Road.

- **Jenolan Caves Road: Hampton** specialist contractors are currently on site carrying out emergency repair work to stabilise the slope. The work is extensive and protracted. It is expected that this section will re-open to single lane traffic within 8 weeks.
- Jenolan Caves Road: Two Mile crews are working hard to clear landslide debris and stabilise slopes. While further investigations need to be carried out, it is expected that this section will reopen by 19 April 2021, weather permitting.
- Jenolan Caves Road: Five Mile preliminary assessments confirmed significant damage to the road and slope. Repairs to the road are complicated and additional geotechnical investigations are required however this road is expected to be closed for an extended period.

Jenolan Caves Road remains closed between Old Bindo Road and Duckmaloi Road as well as between Binoomea Ridge Trail and the Bicentennial National Trail. Motorists are asked to stay informed via <u>Live Traffic.</u> Access to local residents will be maintained within the soft closure points; this also extends to residents guests and any services or public transport needing local access.
