Further night work on Memorial Avenue, Kellyville from 14 November

The NSW Government is upgrading Memorial Avenue to a four lane road to meet the future transport needs of Sydney's northwest.



Earlier this month, Roads and Maritime Services wrote to you about work happening in your area to prepare for the Memorial Avenue upgrade that will begin major work next year.

This work involves relocating overhead power lines underground. While we will be working along all of Memorial Avenue, at the moment most of our work is near the intersections with Arnold Avenue and the NW Transitway.

We have reviewed our schedule for this work and have identified an opportunity to carry out further night shifts and ensure we complete this work on time. We are proposing to increase our night work schedule from two nights per week to four nights per week.

We have doorknocked and spoken to the nearby community about this increased work schedule and have identified support for us to work these extra shifts. We have committed to scheduling nights with no work after two nights to (for example, two nights of work, one night break, two nights of work). This schedule will continue until the end of November.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for **60 day** and **30 night shifts** between **14 November 2019** and **31 January 2020**, weather permitting. We will not work on public holidays.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturday**. Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Monday** to **Friday**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by midnight.

We will work four nights per week until the end of November. In December and January we will continue working at night. To minimise impact, we will be staging our work at different locations along Memorial Avenue. We will not be working in one location for more than two nights per week.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
