Relocating utilities near Memorial Avenue, Kellyville from 21 October

The NSW Government is upgrading Memorial Avenue to a four lane road to meet the future transport needs of Sydney's northwest.



Each day nearly 30,000 motorists use Memorial Avenue to travel to their homes, jobs, schools, public transport, shops and services. Currently motorists experience heavy congestion, slow travel times and long delays.

Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading Memorial Avenue from a two lane to a four lane road with the option to expand to six lanes if needed in the future. This will improve traffic flow, ease congestion and reduce travel times along Memorial Avenue and nearby roads especially during the morning and afternoon peaks.

To prepare for this upgrade we need to relocate the existing electrical cabling. The new cables will be placed underground. The new location of the underground cables will not encroach on any private property. It will take eight months to complete this work. During the first few months, we will relocate the cables along Memorial Avenue between Old Windsor Road and Hector Court.

Construction on the upgrade will begin in mid-2020.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for **60 day** and **35 night shifts** between **21 October 2019** and **31January 2020**, weather permitting. We will not work on public holidays.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturday**. Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Monday** to **Friday**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by midnight.

To minimise impact, we will be staging our work at different locations along Memorial Avenue. We will not be working in one location for more than two nights per week or six nights per month.
