Community consultation report available for the proposed Memorial Avenue Upgrade, Kellyville

Following community consultation in December 2013 and January 2014, Roads and Maritime Services has published a report summarising community consultation on the preliminary concept design for the Memorial Avenue Upgrade.

Roads and Maritime developed a preliminary concept design to widen Memorial Avenue from a two lane road to a four lane divided road, between Old Windsor Road and Windsor Road at Kellyville.

From December 2013 to January 2014 community feedback was sought on the preliminary concept design. Roads and Maritime would like to thank everyone who took the time to review the proposal and provide feedback.

Community feedback

Roads and Maritime received 54 responses and overall there was support for the proposed upgrade. There were a number of requests to prioritise the implementation of the project because of the increased development and traffic in the area.

The importance of an integrated local road system was also a key theme in the community comments. This is principally related to the development of the Balmoral Road release area.

Other feedback received included general accessibility, bus facilities, construction, environment, traffic lights, safety and local traffic movements.

Roads and Maritime has prepared a community consultation report which provides a summary of comments and responses. The report is available to view on Roads and Maritime's website

Next steps

Roads and Maritime will incorporate the community feedback when preparing the concept design and environmental impact assessment.

The next stage of consultation will be the exhibition of the concept design and the Review of Environmental Factors. This is expected to take place at the end of 2014.
