

Night work on Memorial Avenue at Kellyville from 30 August

August 2021

The NSW Government is upgrading Memorial Avenue to ease congestion, improve travel times and meet the future transport needs for Sydney's growing northwest.

These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-Safe plan is in place, including the use of face masks and QR codes.

What are we doing?

Night work will be carried out for the upgrade between **30 August and 30 September 2021 from 8pm to 5am Monday to Friday**, weather permitting. However, our work crews may be on site from 6pm to prepare for the shift and set up safety equipment. We will be working on the following dates, weather permitting:

20 September – 24 September	Utility services relocation on Memorial Avenue near the T- Way	2 nights
	Utility services relocation on Memorial Avenue near Free Settlers Drive	2 nights
27 September – 30 September	Utility services relocation on Old Windsor Road at the intersection of Sunnyholt Road	2 nights

How will the work affect you?

This work will be completed at night to reduce traffic disruption and any risks to the workers and road users during the day.

The work will involve some use of noisy machinery. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible, completing nosier work earlier in the evening and turning off vehicles when not in use.

Directly affected residents will be advised about the expected night work near their property and the measures being taken to lessen the disturbance during the work.



Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Partial lane closures and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be place. Travel times may be affected by up to five minutes.
