



# Work on Memorial Avenue at Kellyville during October

The NSW Government is upgrading Memorial Avenue to ease congestion, improve travel times and meet the future transport needs for Sydney's growing north west.

These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-Safe plan is in place, including the use of face masks and QR codes.

### What are we doing?

We will be working on the following activities in October:

- Utility services relocation and installation
- Construction of a drain
- · Digging for the new road
- Property adjustments including removal of existing signs, installation of noise wall
- Bridge work at Strangers Creek including laying support for the bridge

## **Night work**

Night work will take place between **Friday 1 October and Friday 29 October** in the following areas, weather and COVID-19 restrictions permitting:

Activity	Length of time
Remove street lights on Old Windsor Road either side of Sunnyholt Road	2 x 2 nights
Utility services relocation on Old Windsor Road near the intersection of Sunnyholt Road	2 x 2 nights
Utility services relocation at the T-way	3 nights
Utility services relocation on Memorial Avenue near the T- Way	3 nights
Utility services relocation on Memorial Avenue near the intersection of Arnold Avenue west	2 x 2 nights
Utility services relocation on Memorial Avenue between Hector Court and McCausland Place	2 x 2 nights
Utility services relocation on Memorial Avenue near the intersection of Stone Mason Drive	2 x 2 nights
Utility services relocation on Windsor Road north of Memorial Avenue	3 nights
Utility services relocation on Windsor Road south of Memorial Avenue	3 nights
Services investigation work – no more than 2 nights at the one location.	


Our night time work hours are from **8pm to 5am Monday to Friday**. However, our work crews may be on site from 6pm to prepare for the shift and set up safety equipment.

### How will the work affect you?

We will be completing some work at night to reduce traffic disruption and any risks to the workers and road users during the day.

The night work will involve some use of noisy machinery. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible, completing nosier work earlier in the evening and turning off vehicles when not in use.

Directly affected residents will be advised about the expected night work near their property and the measures being taken to lessen the disturbance during the work.



# **Traffic changes**

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make the work zone safe. Partial lane closures and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be place. Travel times may be affected by up to five minutes.
