

Investigation work on King Georges Road, Hurstville

March 2022

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) is making improvements to the intersection of King Georges Road and Connells Point Road, South Hurstville to improve traffic flow, travel times and safety for all road users, particularly during peak periods.

What are we doing?

We are carrying out investigation work on King Georges Road, between Connells Point Road and William Street, Hurstville between **28 March and 30 June 2022**, weather permitting. The investigations will be conducted after hours for two weeks during this time to ensure King Georges Road remains open to traffic during the day, specifically during peak periods.

These investigations will allow us to gather information about ground conditions and assist us in developing designs for future road improvements.

How will the work impact me?

Our work will include:

- Topographic surveying
- Potholing
- Core-hole drilling
- Excavation works
- Pavement testing

This work will involve some noisy activities. We will use noise mitigation measures to limit impacts on the community including completing noisier activities by midnight, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, and noise monitoring.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes while workers are on site including a reduced speed limit of 40km/h for the work zone. Lane closures and footpath closures may be in place, however traffic flow along King Georges Road will be maintained.
