



Project update – Proposed new and extended clearways on Roberts Road and King Georges Road, between Greenacre and Beverly Hills

The NSW Government is acting to reduce congestion and delays on Sydney's roads by introducing clearways.

In March 2014, Roads and Maritime Services consulted the community on a proposal to install new and extended clearways on Roberts Road and King Georges Road. As a result of community and stakeholder feedback, we revised our proposed clearway hours of operation and alternate business parking arrangements, to ensure there was a balance between local business parking needs, traffic flow and to provide consistent clearway hours along the corridor.

Roads and Maritime Services again invited feedback in November 2016 on the revised proposal to extend the current weekday clearways and introduce new weekend clearways along the same corridor. We have included a map to show the proposal.

We received 50 responses from people and organisations with 39 supporting the proposal and 11 providing suggestions or raising concerns. Key matters raised include extending the proposed clearway hours and suggested consideration for additional clearways.

We have summarised the feedback and our responses to the revised proposal in a community consultation report, which is available on our website at rms.nsw.gov.au/clearways.

After considering all responses, along with the proposal's aim and design requirements, we will move forward with our revised proposal, with clearways to operate on King Georges Road from **6am** to **7pm weekdays** and **9am** to **6pm weekends** and **public holidays**. We have included a map to show the location of the new and extended clearways.

We have been working with Canterbury-Bankstown Council to deliver improved parking on The Boulevarde and Lakemba Street at Wiley Park. Council is expected to commence construction of a new car park on The Boulevarde in February 2018 and complete construction in April. Timed parking restrictions and loading zones on Lakemba Street and The Boulevarde will be established when the new car park opens.

Following the parking changes the new and extended clearways will be installed on Roberts Road and King Georges Road. We will notify you prior to installation of the clearways.
